COMPULSORY MEASURES FOR EPIDEMIOLOGICAL PREVENTION

NOTE: All specific measures presented in this material will be supplemented with the latest sets of instructions issued by the authorities on the date of the event.

Drivers, technical teams, officials, referees, members of the organizing team and media representatives are required to comply with all measures imposed by the authorities and the organizer, contained in the Joint Order of the Ministry of Youth and Sports and the Ministry of Health No. 1219 / 1634 / 2020, regarding the conduct and organization of motor sports competitions.

Measures regarding personal hygiene and social distancing remain permanent and mandatory during the competition, starting with the arrival at the competition venue:

- Own space for disinfection for each technical team;
- Physical distance both in the technical spaces and in the regrouping park;
- Wearing a protective mask;
- Using online communication with the organizer, race management and media representatives;

Competitors licensed annually for CNRB, CNRVIB or CNR2B or One Event who wish to participate in **Perla Harghitei Rally** must complete and send to the email address **inscrieri@autorally.ro** the following documents:

1. Crew entry form

This includes the billing data, the scrutineering form, the entry form for reconnaissance and the summary for administrative checks.

2. Team entry form

It is available on: www.raliulharghitei.ro.

To be completed only by FRAS licensed teams.

3. COVID-19 Questionnaire

It is available on: www.raliulharghitei.ro.

The registration will be validated only if the COVID-19 Questionnaires will be sent in the period specified in the Supplementary Regulations - Art. 3 (Schedule in chronogical order and locations).

4.3 Number of competitors accepted and classes

4.3.1 The number of competition shall be limited to: 80

If the maximum number of entrants is exceeded, the last crews who have entred and paid the entry fee will be placed on a waiting list and not on the official registration list. The organizer reserves the right to decide which of the non-priority entrants will be accepted.

IMPORTANT! The crews participating in both CNRB and CNRB / Tarmac will pay the CNRB entry fee \pm 500 RON CNRB / Tarmac fee.

Any entry form received after the closing date for entries, Tuesday, 4 May 2021, at 18:00, will be accepted with the increased payment of the entry fee by 50%.

4.5 Payment

After sending the entry form, the competitors will receive the invoice related to the registration fee. Competitors will pay the invoice received from the organizer **no later** than Wednesday, 5 May 2021 and will send proof of payment to the email address inscrieri@autorally.ro.

Under no circumstances, the bank transfer related to the entry fee be made before receiving the invoice.

Cash payment is not allowed on the spot!

4.6 Entry fee refounds

The entry fee shall be refunded in full:

If the rally does not take place;

Competitors whose entry form is not accepted.

The entry fee will be partially refunded:

- 75 % competitors whose entry has not been validated;
- 50 % competitors who, due to force majeure, attested / certified by FRAS, are unable to start.

ART, 5, INSURANCE

The insurance fee included in the registration fee guarantees competitors coverage for any civil damages against third parties. The competitors will be insured against third parties in the amount of 100,000 RON.

- **5.1** This insurance will be concluded for all people within the rally organization (especially Officials) and co-drivers (on all Special Stages), acredited journalists / photographers and drivers with a foreign drivers's license, demanding that there is no other casualty insurance concluded by a local or foreign insurance company.
- 5.2 Legal liability insurance is compulosory for all cars participating at the rally. This has to be contracted by the owner of the car. The legal liability insurance has to cover all damages on all routes excepting the Special Stages and the Shakedown. The existence of this legal liability insurance has to be proved at the administrative check..
- 5.3 Service, reconnaissance and auxiliary cars are excluded from this organization liability cover insurance. In case of any accident with only material and no human damages, the competitor has the absolute obligation to report such damages immediately at the following Time Control Point. A detailed written report at the end of the Leg must be filled in at the Rally HQ. Furthermore, in case of physical damage, the driver must immediately inform the Rally HQ.

ART, 6, ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

See Supplementary Regulations - Appendix IV (Decals and supplementary advertising)

6.1 Organizer obligatory advertising

"Perla Harghitei Rally"

The advertising for the competition car are picked up from the Rally HQ (Odorheiu Secuiesc, Septimia Hotel) by each competitor or by a representative of the crew according to the Supplementary Regulations - Art. 3 (Schedule in chronological order and locations). They are applied to the car until the scrutineering. It is not allowed to cut these panels.

6.2 FRAS obligatory advertising: According CNRB 2021 Regulations.

6.3 Advertising for participating crew partners

All crews registered for the Perla Harghitei Rally will be able to organize sports advertising activities (tent, branding, sampling, hostess, autograph sessions, etc.) only in the area allocated within the Service Park.













Rally locations: start / finish area, prize giving ceremony, press conference room, VIP area, are exclusive locations for the organizer's partners. Competitors may organize sports advertising activities in these areas only with the written consent of the organizer (by contract). Otherwise, the organizer will sanction the crew with a fine of 2500 RON.

The promotion of the crew partner in the form of commercial advertising (direct promotion of product, services, offers) without the written consent of the organizer (by contract), is interpreted as prohibited advertising and will be sanctioned by the organizer a fine of 5000 RON.

6.4 Failure to comply with Art. 6.1, respectively Art. 6.2 is sanctioned with the refusal to start.

ART. 9. RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance will be according to 2021 CNRB Regulations - Art. 24. The reconnaissance schedule is published in Supplementary Regulations - Appendix II.

The reconnaissance will not be monitored by marshals at the start and stop of Special Stages. Competitors are required to use the GPS system. Competitors are solely responsible for starting and operating the GPS system. Failure to comply with the provisions of this aligned is sanctioned by the Clerk of the Course as follows: the first offense with a fine of 250 RON, the second offense with a fine of 1250 RON, the third offense with the refusal to start.

Any involvement of a crew in a road event or accident during reconnaissance will be reported immediately to the official Competitor's Relations Officer or to the emergency phone and may be sanctioned by the Clerk of the Course with a fine, exclusion or proposal to suspend the license.

9.1 Entry procedure

The registration form for reconnaissance is an integral part of the entry form. This will be sent to the e-mail address **inscrieri@autorally.ro**. Cars used in the rally cannot be used for reconnaissance.

The reconnaissance numbers will be used.

9.2 Specific regulations

- **9.2.1** During the reconnaissances, the Romanian Road Code must be observed, including the speed limits. Please note that during the reconnaissance, Special Stages will not be closed to public road traffic.
- **9.2.2** The maximum speed allowed for the reconnaissance of Special Stages is according to the Romanian Road Code (for National and County Roads the speed limit is 90 km / h; a tolerance of 10 km / h is allowed), unless speed restrictions are imposed on the road. These restrictions determine the maximum speed allowed. Additional limitations may be marked in the Road Book.













- **9.2.3** Exceeding the speed limit during reconnaissance for Special Stages and Shakedown will result in a fine by the Clerk of the Course after the following: 50 RON for each kilometer per hour above the speed limit. The fine applies when the speeding has been for more than 10s (in the case of GPS system measurements). The fines are paid to FRAS until the First Stewards Meeting, under the sanction of refusing to start.
- **9.2.4** Any other offense of the provisions of the Romanian Road Code during the reconnaissance will attract a penalty from the Stewards, according to 2021 CNRB Regulation Art. 34.3.4.
- **9.2.5** The amount of the fines will not change in the case of any other fine imposed by the police. The amount of the fine will be doubled if the offense is repeated during the same rally.
- **9.2.6** In the event of a offense of traffic law committed by a competitor participating in the rally, the police officers or officials who found the offense must inform the offender in this way, in the same way as in the case of regular road users.
- **9.2.7** If the police or officials decide not to stop the offender, they may request that the penalties provided for in the legislation be applied, provided that:
- Notification of the offense is received officially and in writing before the publication of the provisional classification.
- The report shall be sufficiently detailed so that the identity of the offending competitor
 is indisputably established, with the exact specification of the place and time at which
 the offense took place.
- The facts alleged not to be susceptible to interpretation.
- 9.2.7 After the first pass on the special stages Liban / Bucin I / Bucin II, subject to the strict observance of the rules imposed by the Romanian Road Code and the strict monitoring through the GPS system, it is approved to return on the same road sector at the start of the special stages Liban / Bucin I / Bucin II for the second reconnaissance pass.

9.3 Collection of speed control checking devices (GPS)

All reconnaissance cars must be equipped with a speed control checking device. This device can be collected according Supplementary Regulations - Art. 3 (Schedule in chronogical order).

The fee for the GPS device is included in the registration fee and is worth 250 RON for CNRB, CNRB / Tarmac, CNRVIB crew and 200 RON for CNR2B.













ART, 10. ADMINISTRATRIVE CHECKS

- 10.1 All documents will be send to the e-mail address: inscrieri@autorally.ro, and the administrative checks, as well as validation of the competitors and teams will be done exclusively online. See Supplementary Regulations Art. 3 and Art. 4.2.
- **10.2** Failure to send at the time mentioned at the Supplementary Regulations Art. 3 (Schedule in chronogical order and locations) of all duly completed documents leads to the invalidation registration.

ART. 11. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

11.1 Location and schedule

According to Supplementary Regulations - Art. 3 (Schedule in chronogical order and locations).

A detailed schedule will be published according to Supplementary Regulations - Art. 3 (Schedule in chronogical order and locations).

Cars may be presented at the scrutineering by a representative of the team.

CNR2B crews who want Shakedown will make the scrutineering on Thursday, 6 May 2021, between 16:30 and 20:30, at the Service Park (regroup zone). CNR2B who don't want Shakedown will make the scrutineering on Friday, 7 May 2021, at the stand of each crew in the Service Park.

At the scrutineering, the GPS monitoring system for the competition cars will be verified.

11.2 Mandatory documents

- Car's complete certified homologation;
- SOS / OK board (A3 format);
- FRAS technical passport.

11.3 Windows

According to the ISC - Appendix J - Art. 253.11

11.4 Drivers safety equipment

The equipment must comply with the ISC - Annex L - Chap. III. The equipment will be checked during the rally. It will not be necessary to present the equipment at the scrutineering.













11.5 Noise level

According to the 2021 CNRB Regulations.

11.6 Special national requirements

It is mandatory that all epidemiological prevention measures be observed by all participants.

11.7 Installing the GPS monitoring system

The GPS monitoring system must be located on all cars. Each crew must install the system before the scrutineering, according to the instructions received by the GPS Official.

Disassembly of the GPS system for One Event licensed crews will be performed in the technical zone before the last entry into the Service Park (TC 12A for CNRB, CNRB / Tramac, CNRVIB and TC 9A for CNR2B) by teh GPS Official.

Both One Event licensed crews and annually licensed crews that do not complete the rally must return the GPS device to Rally HQ by Saturday, 8 May 2021, at 19:30. Loss, non-delivery or damage to the equipment will result in a fine of 2500 RON, paid to FRAS.

ART, 12, OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1. CEREMONIAL START PROCEDURES AND ORDER

The ceremonial start is mandatory for all CNRB, CNRB / Tarmac, CNRVIB crews and optional for CNR2B crews. It will take place on Thursday, 6 May 2021, at the Marton Aron Square of Odorheiu Secuiesc, starting with 20:00. The order for the festive start will be announced.

The crews will follow the instructions of the officials present.

During parking before the ceremonial start, respectively during the ceremonial start, the anti-COVID-19 health protocol must be observed: wearing a protective mask and maintaining social distance.

12.2. CEREMONIAL FINISH

The ceremonial finish will consist in awarding the first three crews from the FIA General Classification and the first three crews form OPEN Classification. The ceremonial finish area will be located at Rákóczi Ferenc Street in regroup zone.

Any delays in TC 12A CNRB, CNRB / Tarmac, CNRVIB and TC 9A CNR2B resulting exclusively from the ceremonial finish will not be penalized.













If, after stopping for the ceremonial finis, Rákóczi Ferenc Street between TC 12A and the roundabout, in order not to disturb the public road traffic, the organizer can request the Clerk of the Course to enter in advance in TC 12A. Competitors will be stationed in the technical area in addition to the ten minutes and during that entered in advance to clock their time in TC 12B.

During the ceremonial finish, the anti-COVID-19 health protocol must be observed: wearing a protective mask and maintaining social distance

The rally ends at TC 12D CNRB, CNRB / Tarmac, CNRVIB and in TC 9D CNR2B.

12.3. PERMITTED EARLY CHECK-IN AND CHANGE OF TIMECARD

- **12.3.1** Crews are authorized to early check-in without incurring any penalty at the following time controls:
- TC 3C, TC 3D, TC 12C, TC 12D (CNRB, CNRB / Tarmac and CNRVIB);
- TC 9C, TC 9D (CNR2B).
- **12.3.2** The timecarb will be issued and / or changed at the following time contols:
- TC 0, TC 3D, TC 3E, TC 6B, TC 9B, TC 12D (CNRB, CNRB / Tarmac and CNRVIB);
- TC 0, TC 3B, TC 6B, TC 9D (CNR2B).

12.4. SHAKEDOWN

12.4.1 Eligibility

Only crews which successfully passed the administrative checks and scrutineering are accepted. Their participation is possible only if applying all regulations as if it were a Special Stage (marking and advertising must be completed, all items of clothing as in the competition, etc.)

A maximum of 5 passes will be allowed.

12.5.3 Allocation and provisions of service areas

In the General Service Park, an area of at least 42 m 2 (6 x 7 m) will be provided by the organiser for each crew. The allocation of additional space is made according to the available space and is charged with 25 RON / m 2 . The organizer reserves the right to check and measure the space provided by it. The detection by the organizer of exceeding the allocated space will be charged with 125 RON / m 2 .

The placement of the crews in the Service Park will be done according to a plan published on the notice board during the week of the rally and following the instructions of the organizer.

It is forbidden to park the trailers inside the Service Park or in any other location that could confuse traffic in the area. The organiser may propose to the Clerk of the Course the sanctioning of crews who do not comply with this rule.

Trailers must be parked in the following location:

12.5.4 Speed limit

According to 2021 CNRB Regulations - Art. 57.4.

12.5.5 Behavior

- Access to the Service Park is allowed only for racing cars and for the technical vehicles identified by the "Service" and / or "Auxiliary" badges distributed by FRAS together with the issuance of licenses.
- Damage to the surface of the Service Park must be avoided. It is forbidden to fix tents in













nails, screws or other materials that can damage the surface. The crew is responsible for any damage to the tarmac surface in the assigned area.

- Under each race car, a waterproof and hydrocarbon-resistant foil must be placed on a sufficiently large surface at all times during service operations.
- Service operations will not lead to permanent and avoidable damage.
- Refueling is only allowed in the area provided for refueling.
- Absurd or intentional behavior against environmental protection is particularly damaging to the image of motorsport and will be punished, even if there are no regulations specific.
- After the rally, the Service Park must be handed over in its original condition. The crews are responsible for the disposal of waste and used fluids.

Any offens of these rules leads to a fine of 5000 RON paid to the organizer until Saturday, 8 May 2021, at 19:30.

12.8. CHICANES

As a safety measure, on the special stage Liban (*km 2,82 and km 11,57*) and Crăciunel (*km 6,08*) will be placed chicanes.

The chicanes are made up of circular bales of straw with a mass of at least 400 kg, which will be placed according to Fig. 12.8, starting from the road axis, with a distance of 10 m between rows.

A marshal will be appointed as a judge of facts to report to the Clerk of the Course all the cars that hit the chicane. Incorrect passage through chicane will be penalized by Clerk of the Course, based on the judge's report.

If an element of the chicane has decreased from the starting position and the division of the required level of competition, the Clerk of the Course may award competitions in the cases of another time for the Special Stage.















The reconnaissance will not be monitored by marshals at the start and stop of Special Stages.

The maximum speed allowed for the recognition of Special Stages is according to the Romanian Road Code (for National and County Roads the speed limit is 90 km / h; a tolerance of 10 km / h is allowed), unless speed restrictions are imposed on the road. These restrictions determine the maximum speed allowed. Additional limitations may be marked in the Road Book.

Exceeding the speed limit during reconnaissance for Special Stages and Shakedown will result in a fine by the Clerk of the Course after the following: 50 RON for each kilometer per hour above the speed limit. The fine applies when the speeding has been for more than 10s (in the case of GPS system measurements). The fines are paid to FRAS until the First Stewards Meeting, under the sanction of refusing to start.

After the first pass on the special stages Liban / Bucin I / Bucin II, subject to the strict observance of the rules imposed by the Romanian Road Code and the strict monitoring through the GPS system, it is approved to return on the same road sector at the start of the special stages Liban / Bucin I / Bucin II for the second reconnaissance pass.











APPENDIX IV - DECALS AND SUPPLEMENTARY ADVERTISING

Below these panels will be placed a rectangle 67 cm long and 5 cm wide, with the name of the championship. This sticker provided by FRAS is compulsory for all the starting crews. Its location cannot be changed.



One rear window panel measuring a maximum of 90 cm wide and 10 cm high shall be positioned at the top in the centre of the rear window.



An adjacent area of 15 cm x 15 cm shall contain a fluorescent orange (PMS 804) 14 cm high competition number on a clear background. This number may be reflective and must be visible from the rear at eye level.



Two numbers for each rear side window which shall be 20 cm high, coloured fluorescent orange (PMS 804), and may be reflective. These numbers shall be placed on the rear side windows adjacent to the crew's name.



One roof panel, 50 cm wide by 52 cm high, to be placed on the roof with the top towards the front of the car. A matt black competition number, 28 cm high, will be displayed on a matt white background 50 cm wide by 38 cm high.



One plate fitting into a rectangle 43 cm wide by 21.5 cm high which shall include at least the competition number and full name of the rally.



Two front door panels measuring 67 cm wide by 17 cm high including a 1 cm white surround. Each of these panels shall comprise a matt black competition number box which shall always be at the front of the panel. Numerals will be fluorescent yellow (PMS 803), 14 cm high. The remainder of this door panel is reserved for the organiser.



The first initial(s) and surname of the driver and the co-driver, as well as the national flags of the country of the ASN from which they have obtained their licences, must appear on the rear side window on both sides of the car, adjacent to the competition number.

The names must be:

- In white Helvetica.
- In upper case for the initial(s) and first letter of each name with the remainder in lower case.
- 6 cm high and with a stroke width of 1.0 cm.

The driver's name shall be the upper name on both sides of the car.













APPENDIX V - EXTRACTS FROM FIA ISC - APPENDIX L

All competitors are reminded of FIA ISC - Appendix L, in particular its Chapter III - Driver's Equipment.

Helmets (FIA ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards:

8858 - 2002 or 8858 - 2010 (Technical List No. 41);
 8859 - 2015 (Technical List No. 49);
 8860 - 2004 or 8860 - 2010 (Technical List No. 33);
 8860 - 2018 or 8860 - 2018 - ABP (Technical List No. 69).

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, FIA ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858. Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List No. 29. See also helmet compatibility chart in ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (FIA ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underweard, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List No. 27) or 8856 - 2018 (Technical List No. 74).

Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates, etc.) <u>as well as concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also FIA-RRSR - Art. 53.1</u>.

Biometric Devices (FIA ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during the rally.

- \bullet If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 or 8868 2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868 - 2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (FIA ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 5)

The wearing of jewellery in the form of body piercing of metal neck chains in prohibited during the competition and may therefore be checked before the start.


